



About Kentaro Miura



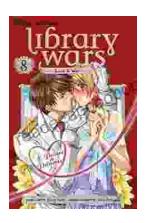
