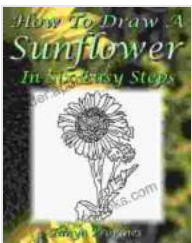

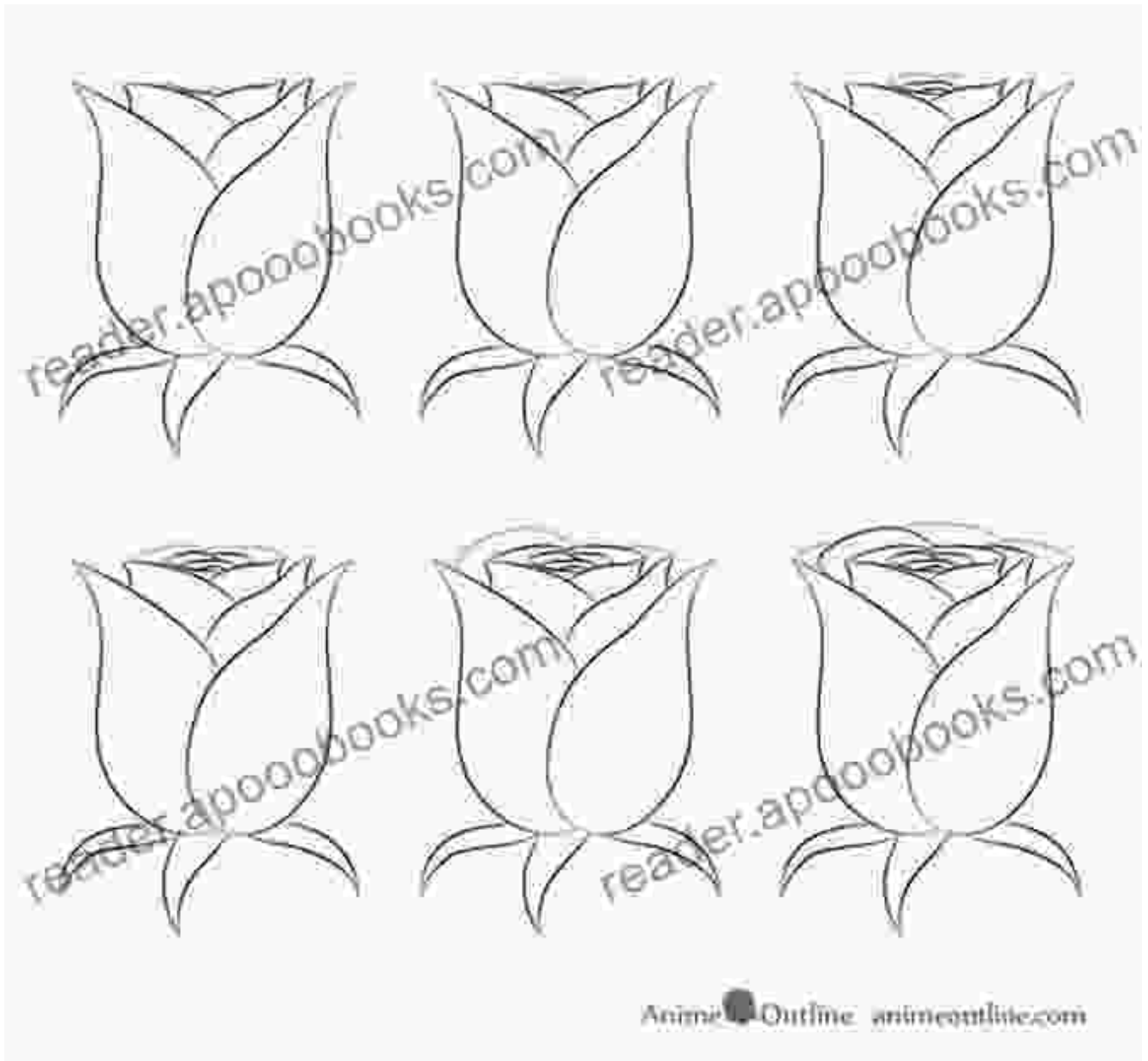
Step 1: Draw The Basic Shape

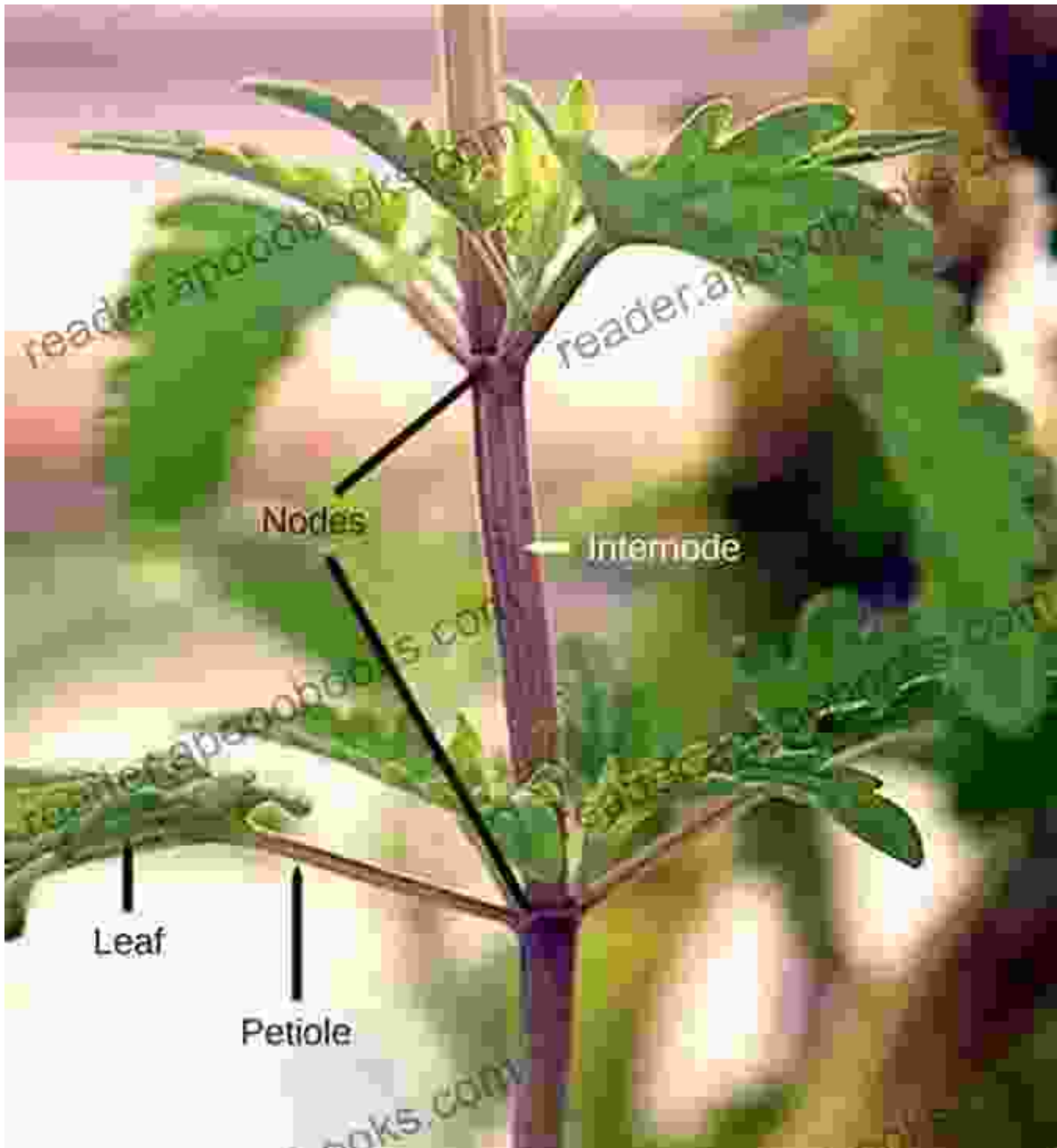

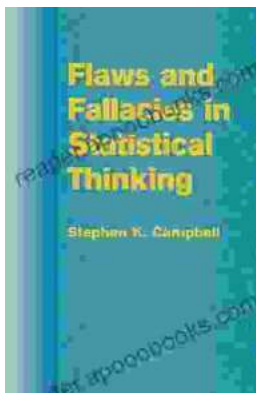
