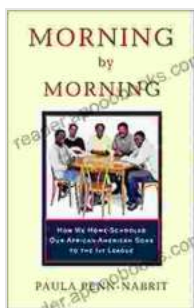


How We Home Schooled Our African American Sons to the Ivy League

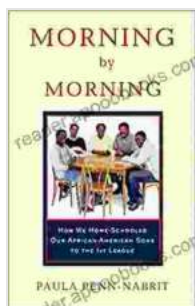
