

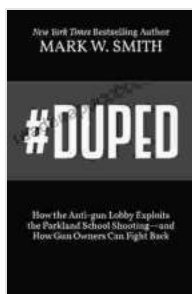

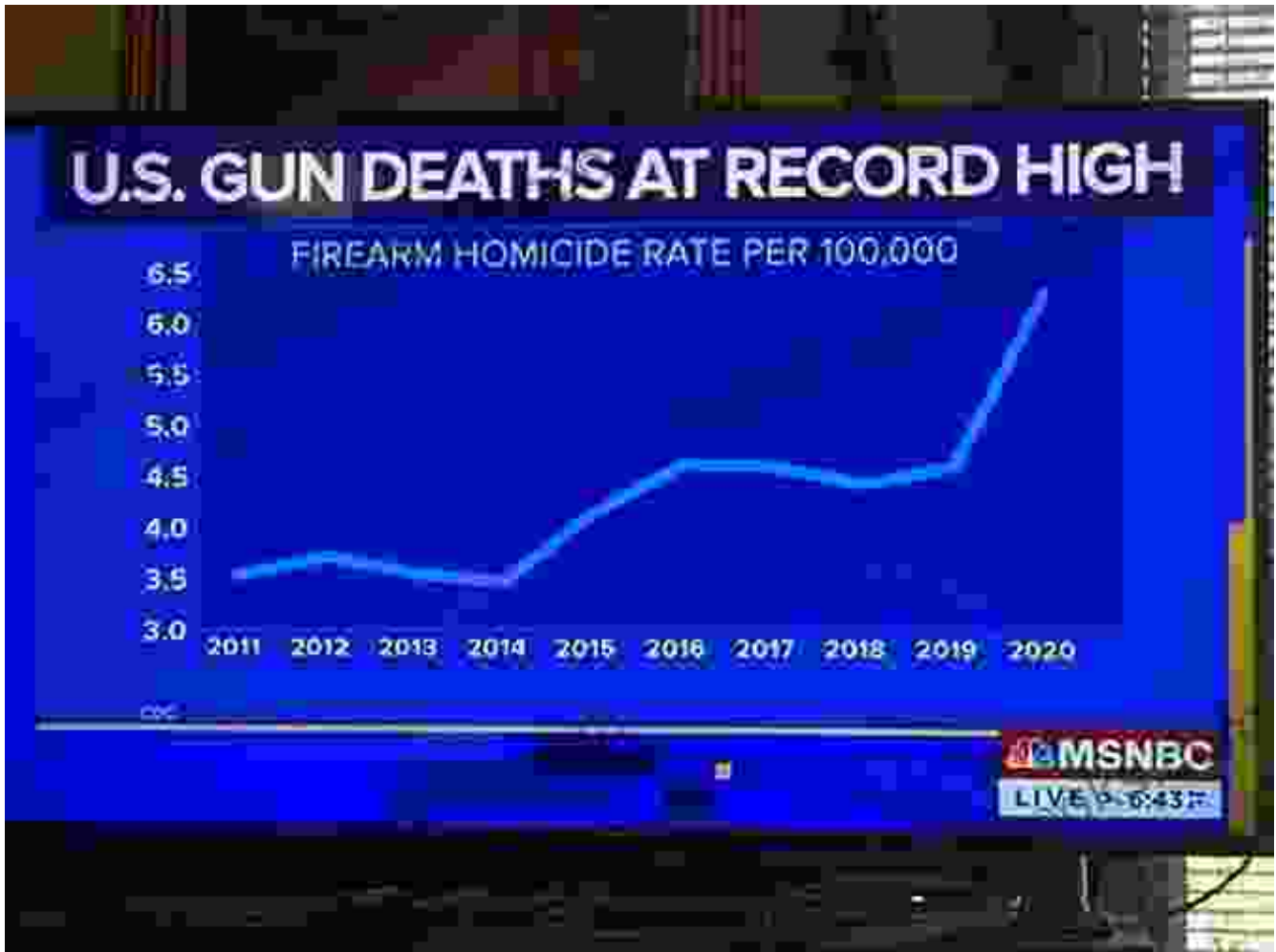

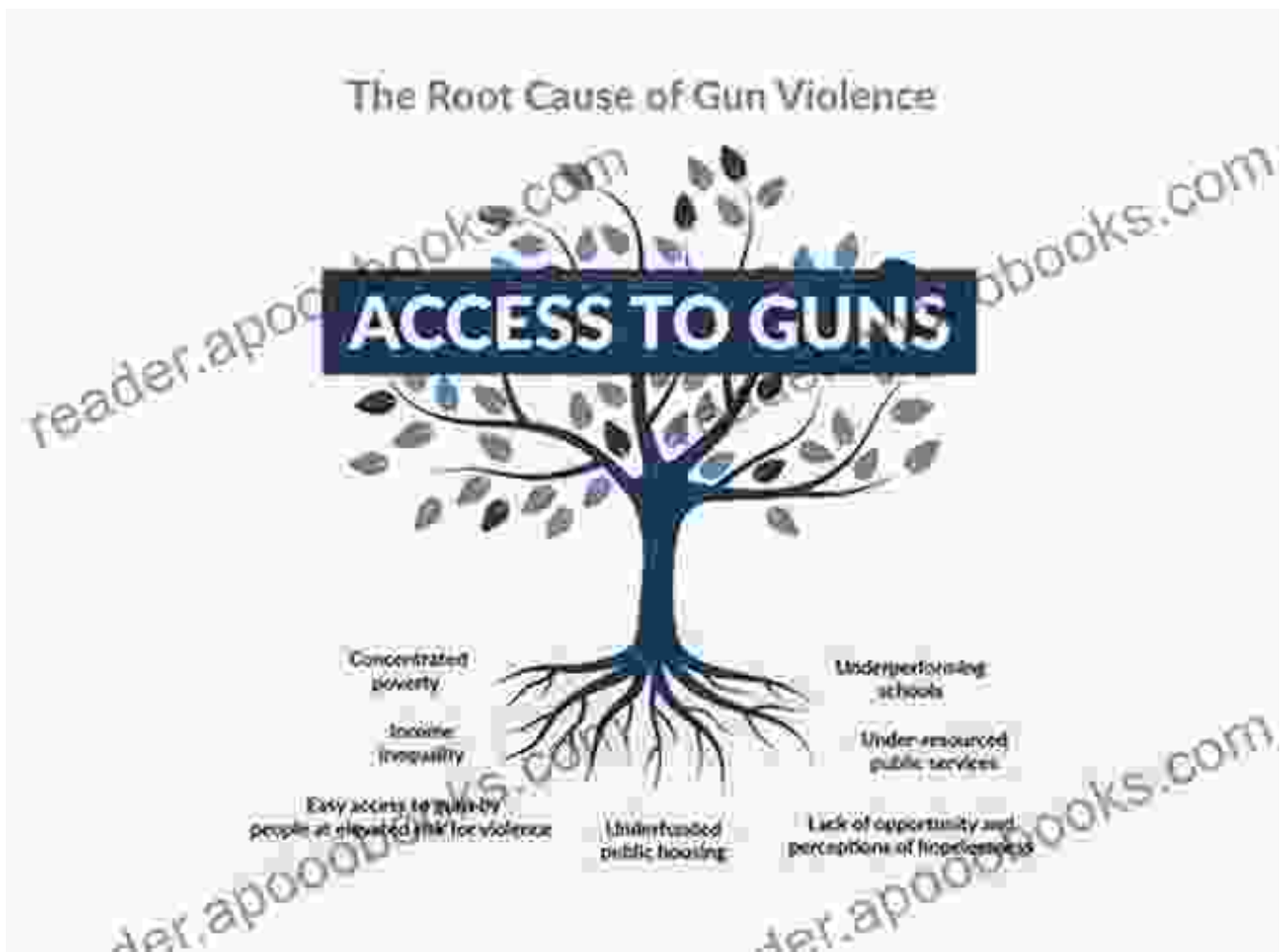
Selective Use of Statistics and Misleading Claims

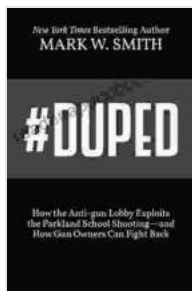


Balancing Gun Rights and Public Safety

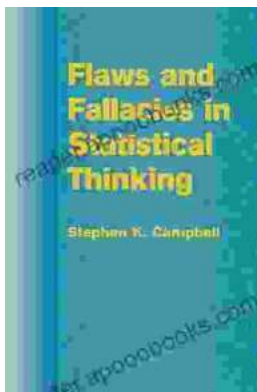
